



## Federal Employees on Furlough during Government Shutdown

On Friday, January 25, 2019, the President signed legislation to re-open the government and to end the temporary shutdown. You have been identified as filing a Nevada Unemployment Insurance (UI) claim while you were on furlough from the Federal Government.

Additionally, back on Wednesday, January 16, 2019, the President signed the Government Employee Fair Treatment Act of 2019, ensuring that all federal furlough employees will receive backpay from the effective date of the furlough.

**If you have or will receive compensation from the federal government for the time you were on furlough and have been paid unemployment insurance benefits, you will be required to repay those benefits. Failure to repay the amount of benefits received may result in collection activities. If you receive a Notification of Overpayment from the department, please read the notice carefully for repayment instructions and any applicable appeal rights.**
