### Clean Slate Criminal Record Sealing

**Get a Court Order sealing of your record!**

#### TO PARTICIPATE IN THE EVENT

- You must go to the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department Records and Fingerprint Bureau at 400 S. Martin Luther King Boulevard, Bldg. C, Monday-Friday, from 8:00 AM – 5:00 PM. to obtain a “scope” and get your fingerprints taken on a fingerprint card. Bring your I.D. and \$24.00. They accept cash, debit, MasterCard, Visa, or Discover.
- Then bring your scope, fingerprint card, and a certified check or money order in the amount of \$23.50 made payable to the Department of Public Safety to Legal Aid Center of Southern Nevada, 725 E. Charleston Blvd., Las Vegas, NV 89104, Monday-Friday, from 8:30 AM – 5:00 PM. where you will sign a form authorizing your records to be sent to the event.

**ALL DOCUMENTS MUST BE RECEIVED BY LEGAL AID CENTER OF SOUTHERN NEVADA BY 8/11/16 IN ORDER TO ATTEND THE EVENT.** For questions, call 702-386-1070 X 1500.

This event only pertains to Las Vegas, North Las Vegas and Henderson criminal records. In order to seal your criminal records, you must meet certain requirements. First, you must wait a number of years after your release, if you were in jail. The clock begins when you complete parole or probation. If you were acquitted or had charges dismissed you can seal those records right away. However, if you have gotten into trouble again since your original charges, you may not be able to get your records sealed immediately. **CRIMES AGAINST CHILDREN, FELONY DUIs, and SEXUAL OFFENSES can never be sealed. In addition, if you were dishonorably discharged from probation on a case, that charge is not eligible for record sealing.**

| Category C or D felony                                                          | 12 years                |
| Category E felony                                                               | 7 years                 |
| Non-felony DUI                                                                  | 7 years                 |
| Non-felony battery domestic violence                                            | 7 years                 |
| Enhanceable misdemeanors                                                        | 7 years                 |
| Gross misdemeanors                                                              | 5 years                 |
| All other misdemeanors                                                          | 2 years                 |
| Acquitted/Dismissed charges or Honorable Discharge on charge under NRS 453.3363 | No wait                 |

### **DIRECTIONS**

The Doolittle Center is located on the southeast corner of W. Lake Mead and J Street.

From I-15, take the W. Lake Mead exit. Travel west on Lake Mead, turn left on J Street. The destination is on your left.

From I-95, take the N. Martin Luther King exit. Travel north on MLK, turn right on W. Lake Mead, turn right on J Street. Destination is on your left.
